1. Check-In Begins at 9:00 am.
2. Admissions after 10:00am will not be judged.
3. Awards will be given for 1st, 2nd, 3rd place as well as Mayor's Choice.
4. Candy must be handed out from participants walking beside floats.
Participants must hand candy to parade watchers on the sidewalk. No candy should be thrown directly from floats.
5. No water balloons, water toys or anything in their likeness should be thrown from floats.
6. Floats including horses, mules, donkeys, etc. will have their own designated scooper-upper for any mess left behind by the livestock.
