

## 2023 Lamb & Wool Quilt Show

The 2023 Lamb and Wool Quilt Show will be held at the Scio Middle School. The showing is free, and everyone is welcome to view the display of quilted Items and vote for the Peoples Choice Award(s). Judging and additional awards may or may not be included in the show.

- No food or drinks are permitted inside the Middle School during the quilt show.
- Please avoid touching or handling the displayed items.
- Children are welcome with the supervision of adults.

### **Filling out the 2023 L&W Quilt Registration Form to Enter a Quilted Item in the Fair**

- Entry fee is \$5.00 for each person entering their quilted item; with one completed registration form per entry.
  - Entry items must be clean, and free of odor and pet hair.
  - Quilts will be in a secure building when not displayed and a team of the Quilt Committee will monitor the quilts and viewers during display times.
1. Section 5, **upper right block at the top of column 2:**
    - Measure your entry item. The length (**top to bottom** measurement of the item) is the first dimension to fill in, and the width is the second dimension.
    - The quilt committee will fill out the remainder of this entire block.
    - \*Please note that any item longer than 45 inches **requires** a 4 inch wide hanging sleeve. Historical entries are the only exception to this requirement. The hanging sleeve is the entrant's responsibility and must be safety-pinned or sewn at the top.
  2. Section 1, Name and contact information: Fill in name, age category, and phone number. If you do not wish to have your personal information public, you may write this information on the back of your entry form.
  3. Section 2, Category of your entry:
    - Simply circle the 2-letter designation which identifies the type of your entry.
  4. Section 3, Method of quilting:
    - Circle the 2-letter designation for the appropriate categories.
    - If someone other than the person piecing the quilt did the 'quilting', please identify the name of the person and/or business on the line below.
  5. Section 4, Receipt (**bottom section of the form which will be given to you at intake and is necessary for you or the designated person to retrieve the quilt entry item.**)
    - Write the name of the **person collecting** the quilt. The quilt committee will supply the identification number.
  6. Section 6, Quilt Title and blocks or patterns: Please provide the name of the quilt, or provide a name for your creation and pattern or block names. Information about the blocks, quilting design, etc. allows others to increase their quilt knowledge.
  7. Section 7, Additional Information: It is always fun to understand more of the process and components involved in making a quilt. This block allows the entrant to share some of that information in an abbreviated fashion and enhances the quilt show with the sharing of this knowledge. If you have more to add, you may attach a 3x5 index card to your entry form.

### **Submission and Return Times and Locations:**

- Entry fee is \$5.00 per person entering one or more items.
- Registration forms are available at lambfair.com and one form must be completed for each item. Hard copies will be made available at the Scio Fire Hall.
- Items longer than 45-inches without a 4-inch hanging sleeve at the top will NOT be accepted.
- Submission at the Scio Fire Hall.
